

MOUNTING THE PEDAL TO THE BASS DRUM:


With the Helix Lever set in the **OPEN POSITION**, slide the pedal onto the bass drum HOOP, in-between the Hoop Tongue and plate pads.

ADJUSTING THE ACTION (SPRING TENSION)

The G-Class pedal features an enclosed, dual bearing spring mount, that can be adjusted by hand using the finger wheel on either side of the frame pillar.




ADJUSTING THE G-DRIVE CAM POSITION


The G-Drive Cam offers the option of two different pivot positions to further vary the pedal's "feel". By repositioning the cam from the back position to forward, it creates a subtle dynamic change in the length of the pedal's stroke and torque ratio while playing.

The G-Drive Cam interlocks with the center block using the notches shown with arrows below. The notches in the cam offer two (forward and back) positions on which the cam can be mounted.

To switch cam positions: using the included tool, loosen the G-Drive Cam bolt as shown. Open the "jaw" wide enough to move the cam to the desired position, and fit the center block tabs into the cam notches.


Securely retighten the G-Drive Cam bolt. Check the cam's alignment on the center block tabs to make sure the tabs are seated into the notches properly.





VARIABLE WEIGHT BEATER SYSTEM
